## Insiaht

Our overall satisfaction across all faith indicators is over 96%. We can attribute this success to our daily activities including breakfast, Gospel readings, communal prayer, monthly school Masses (K-6), the "Growing in Faith, Growing in Christ" curriculum, annual student retreats and the strengthening of our relationship with Father Rodel and the Sacred Heart Church.

# Insights

- Student Learning Engagement: Assumption School's results match the provincial average, with 71.5% of students enjoying Language Arts and Math. Improvements are linked to teacher professional development, cross-grade reading, and classroom libraries. Targeted interventions and a review of ERI/ER programs are planned
- Education Quality: Satisfaction on Education Quality was strong from all stakeholders' perspectives. There are many reasons for this strong result, with Writer's Workshop, ongoing support in professional learning, collaborative efforts, and stability in staffing earning the trust of parents.
- Parental Involvement: Parental involvement satisfaction increased by 22.2% and is 18% above the provincial average, driven by inclusion in Ward meetings, active School Council participation, and effective social media communication.
- Education Quality: Assumption School maintained excellent results with an 89.3% satisfaction rate. Success is
  attributed to staff expertise, CTR support, and the effective use of Reader's and Writer's Workshop, which has
  significantly improved student engagement and achievement, particularly in upper grades. Collaborative teaching
  fosters personalized learning, while staff stability and dedication have built strong community trust and support.
